Car ownership and industry foundation

As of September 2023, car ownership in Chengdu and the neighbouring Chongqing have both surpassed six million units each, the first and third highest across China respectively¹. Currently, there are 45 vehicle manufacturers and over 1,600 parts and components suppliers in the Sichuan-Chongqing region, meeting a localisation rate of over 80%².



New energy and connected mobility

- Sichuan-Chongqing converges new energy vehicle brands including AITO, Deepal, SINOTRUK, Volvo, and ZEEKR, as well as tier one battery suppliers including CALB and CATL.
- The Sichuan-Chongqing Intelligent Terminal Innovation Corridor will promote the first local standards for smart highways. The growing infrastructure will also give way to road testing for connected autonomous driving.



Vehicle consumption and culture

The unique geography and culture of Southwest China have promoted the vehicle consumption. Cities like Chengdu, Chongqing and automotive theme parks self-driving car campsites, racing circuits, drive-in cinemas, restaurants and hotels to create diversified and customised consumption scenarios for car owners. The advances support the vehicle sales, aftermarket and customising, used cars financial and other service markets.

- Leveraging the geographical advantages of the New International Land-Sea Trade Corridor, Southwest China is an
 important gateway for trading with ASEAN states. With established global networks and buyer resources, CAPAS
 invites government representatives, industry organisations and traders from Southeast Asia, Central Asia and the
 Middle East in efforts to facilitate business exchange and market investment.

Advancing sustainable development through the integration of industry and education

Rapidly growing sales and production volumes of new energy vehicles, in addition to a greater awareness of car servicing have raised requirements on professional skills and service levels.

To tackle the skills gap, CAPAS will unite with the relevant authorities, professional institutions and industry organisations for the first time to launch The Integration of Industry and Education in Southwest China Forum, New Energy Vehicle Diagnostics and Maintenance Skills Training, and Automotive Service Skill and Car Films Master Championship.
