# Highlighting Southwest China's automotive potential, innovation, and sustainable development

CAPAS Chengdu 2026 will leverage Southwest China's position as an automotive industry hub within the country by working with industrial clusters and leading enterprises. The show will focus on collaboration between OEM and parts manufacturers, new energy and intelligent connectivity, expansion into overseas markets, and the area's distinct automotive culture. As a result, CAPAS fosters an integrated ecosystem within Sichuan and Chongqing that spans the entire supply chain.

This edition is committed to helping the industry build a more resilient and competitive supply chain by displaying developments in key sectors, such as commercial vehicles, customising products, intelligent chassis, maintenance and repair solutions, three-electric systems, vehicle-road-cloud-integration systems, and more.

Furthermore, various fringe events and services offer opportunities for expansion and resource integration by connecting exhibitors with global buyers.

## Seizing opportunities within the regional supply chain

- Sichuan province produced a total of 262,000 new energy vehicles (NEVs) from January to November in 2025, a year-on-year increase of 142.6%<sup>1</sup>, making it China's third-largest automotive industry cluster.
- CHANGAN Automobile, a prominent carmaker based in Chongqing, sources parts for its flagship models from 50 suppliers in Sichuan, reflecting strong regional collaboration and supporting the development of 683 partners within its supply chains<sup>2</sup>.



## Accelerated efforts to electrify commercial vehicles<sup>3</sup>

- Sichuan sold over 5,800 new energy heavy-duty trucks in the first half of 2025, ranking third nationwide and accounting for 7.3% of national sales.
- The province has also established over 80 heavy-duty truck charging and battery swapping stations, along with more than 2,300 highway charging points.


## Strong growth potential in Southwest China's aftermarket

- With vehicle count surpassing six million in 2024, Chongqing is ranked among the top three cities for ownership in China<sup>4</sup>.
- The city's automotive aftermarket valuation amounted to RMB 85 billion (approximately USD 12 billion) in 2024, a 12.3% increase from the year before<sup>4</sup>. By 2027, Sichuan's vehicle ownership is expected to reach 18.5 million with the aftermarket projected to total RMB 700 billion (approximately USD 100 billion)<sup>5</sup>.

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# What to expect at CAPAS Chengdu 2026



**Bringing together industry resources to drive development of new energy and intelligent connected mobility**

The Chengdu-Chongqing Dual-City Economic Rim Zone will showcase advancements in core systems, such as intelligent chassis, smart cockpit solutions, thermal management, three-electric systems, and vehicle-road-cloud integration. It will also feature industrial clusters from cities like Guang'an, Nanchong, Yibin, and Ziyang.

The New Energy & Intelligent Connected Mobility Zone will include displays focused on the smart manufacturing accomplishments of the Chengdu-Chongqing economic rim, alongside networking events that facilitate tech innovation, digitalisation, and the green transition.

## Focusing on commercial vehicles and chassis products to meet the demands of Southwest China's aftermarket

The Parts & Components Sourcing Zone will feature leading brands, such as Evamo, Ruiming, and Xinruili. With the demand for chassis maintenance rising, the included **Chassis Zone** will address aftermarket needs and focus on new developments, presenting solutions for steering, braking, and related components.

Furthermore, the **Commercial Vehicle Zone** will explore emerging trends in electrification through manufacturing solutions, spare parts, repair technologies, aftermarket skills training for NEVs, and charging infrastructure.

In addition, the upgraded **Repair Zone** is set to enable service franchises to adapt to the latest trends in low-carbon initiatives and electrification, emphasising products like eco-friendly car wash systems and repair tools tailored for NEVs.



## Highlighting automotive lifestyle and customising trends

The Accessories & Customising Zone will feature brands like Botny and Wesley, who will present performance and cleaning products, while Carpro and Wanshun will display a complete series of vehicle films. The zone will also highlight more products for automotive care, lubricants and oils, modifications, and more.

Elsewhere, the **Car Customising Festival** will be an immersive experience of Southwest China's unique automotive culture, including racing simulators, vintage cars, lowriders, and supercars. This initiative supports the growth of Sichuan's motorsport landscape and fosters the development of a road-trip camping hub by promoting specialised automotive products.



# Fringe programme aligns with market trends and supports industry players

To meet the various demands of the automotive industry, diverse fringe events will encourage companies to explore the latest market developments. The events include:

**China Automotive Industry Supply Chain International Cooperation Conference** will bring together representatives from consulates, local government agencies, trade organisations, domestic and international industry experts, and corporate executives to discuss supply chain security and competitiveness, green and low-carbon development, as well as electrification and intelligent transformation, while also promoting investment projects in the Sichuan-Chongqing region.

**Electric Commercial Vehicle Logistics Scenario Application Development Conference** will facilitate discussions on industry advancements and invite companies throughout the value chain to engage in a range of topics, such as optimising current technologies, increasing operational efficiency, resource consolidation, cross-border collaboration, integrating ECV operations with other aspects of the logistics ecosystem, vehicle compatibility in different applications, and more.

**International Automotive Industry Education and Talent Development Conference** will host training sessions focused on upskilling in new energy and intelligent vehicle repair, as well as driving system maintenance.

**Supply Chain Matchmaking Events Series** will convene leading OEMs and key component suppliers, allowing exhibitors to discover new collaborative opportunities.

**VIP Buyers Business Matching Programme** will welcome international buyers from areas such as Central and Southeast Asia. In cooperation with organisations and overseas representatives in Sichuan and Chengdu, its goal is to match supply with demand while generating investment and export opportunities.
